



Call for Book Award Submissions

Following the tradition launched a few years ago, the Hungarian Society for the Study of English calls for nominations and submissions for the 2015 Book Award. We are expecting books (preferably monographs, but also non-monographical one-author volumes) to be submitted to the Book Award Committee for preview. The volumes are to be submitted by the authors themselves for the award. Both printed books and e-books are eligible to nominate, on condition they have a publisher and an ISBN number.

Conditions:

1. books in the broadly defined area of English studies (corresponding to the research areas as outlined by the Constitution of HUSSE: <http://husse-esse.hu/about/constitution/>), published either in English or in Hungarian, either in 2013 or in 2014 can be submitted in the following two categories:
 - a. junior (first book)
 - b. senior;
2. the author of the book must be a fee-paying member of HUSSE at the moment of submission (before submitting the volume, please, check the membership list at <http://husse-esse.hu/membership/>, and in the case of any problem or uncertainty, contact the Society's administrator, Kotricz Károlyné at [husse93 \[at\] yahoo.com](mailto:husse93[at]yahoo.com));
3. submission deadline: 15 December 2014 (by postmark or in person).

The shortlist of the three runners-up and the winner of each category will be announced at a public ceremony at the HUSSE 12 conference, 29-31 January 2014, University of Debrecen.

The books, with a nomination cover letter indicating the category (junior/first book or senior), should be sent to the following address:

N.B.1. The submitted books will not be returned, but deposited as part of the HUSSE special collection recently created at the registered seat of HUSSE (4032 Debrecen, Egyetem tér 1.). The books will be available for public use, including their registration in online catalogues and databases, and will also be available for inter-library loan services (as some previous submissions already are).

N.B.2. The book award is not the same as the book presentation session—for the latter: see another call.
